
### In women who smoke during pregnancy:

## Effects

### Antenatal

### Neonatal

- Spontaneous abortion
- Placenta previa
- **Placental abruption**
- **Preterm labour**
- PROM\*
- IUGR\*
- Low birth weight
- Teratogenic
- Increased perinatal mortality
- Stillbirth
- SIDS\*

### Long Term

- Childhood asthma  $\bullet$
- ADHD\*
- Behavioural problems

**Risk Factors for** 





Be NON-JUDGMENTAL with patient choices



Have frequent and regular **FOLLOW-UP** on patients' cessation efforts



#### Watch for signs of nicotine WITHDRAWAL

Irritability	Fatigue
Anxiety	Insomnia
Restlessness	Poor concentration

### **Continued Smoking**

- High pre-pregnancy smoking frequency
- Age <u>></u> 35
- Increased stress
- Lack of social support
- Low level of education
- Living with someone who smokes
- Inuit self-identification

### Management



Address social supports

#### Counselling

Community Resources

Nicotine Replacement Bupropion Therapy

### **Psychosocial**

- 1st line
- Practice motivational interviewing without judgment
- Educate patients about risks of smoking in pregnancy
- Connect with online resources and community support groups

### **Pharmacologic**

- 2nd line
- Bupropion is Category C during pregnancy
- Nicotine replacement is Category D
- Always use lowest effective use
